Day 5 Morning session: Thinking about competition

Activity 3: Evaluation – what have we learnt this week?

Time required: 1 hour

You will need

- Lined A4 paper
- Charters from Day 2 (morning) Activity 3, 'Introducing goals'.

Aims

- To give pupils time to reflect on their learning this week.
- To allow pupils to revisit the goals they set for themselves on Day 2 and provide the opportunity to amend them in the light of subsequent learning.

What to do

Finish and present any work from previous sessions, as appropriate.

Ask pupils to write down some highlights of the week – what have they most enjoyed doing? Next ask pupils to write down what they have learnt from the week. A prompt might be: What do I now know that I did not know at the start? Point out that this can include learning about process (for example how to be an effective member of a team or how to carry out research) as well as facts.

Go on to consider what they would they like to find out more about in the future.

Finally, is there anything they hope to do differently in the future as a result of their experiences this week? With this in mind, ask pupils to look again at the 'charter' of goals they wrote on Day 2 (see Introducing goals). Is there anything they would like to add or alter? After some time to think about this, ask pupils if they would like to share any changes they have made with the class.
