

Bring on the World

Day 3 Afternoon session: A fair competition?

Activity 1: Presentation of country research

Time required: 1 hour

You will need

- Notes and posters from country research (see Days 1 and 2)

Aims

- To give pupils an opportunity to present information to others.
- To develop speaking and listening skills.
- To find out about countries playing in the World Cup.
- To evaluate their experience of working as a team.

What to do

Ask some of the groups to present their country research on a poster or another kind of display. Afterwards spend some time allowing pupils to discuss any information which particularly interested or surprised them.

After each presentation spend a couple of minutes asking the group how they felt they performed as a team, drawing out what worked well, and what was less successful. Useful questions to ask are: Did everyone have a chance to express their ideas and did everyone listen? Did everyone pull their weight? If not, why not? Is there anything you could have done better? Other pupils in the class could be encouraged to give positive feedback, and, perhaps, some constructive criticism.

At the end of the session, list positive and negative experiences on the board and ask pupils for suggestions of ways in which they could work more effectively next time.
