Activity 2.4: Local global question time

Ages: 8+

Aim

To sum up and reinforce what pupils have learnt from the previous activities.

What to do

Ask the class to form groups of 3–4 and ask them to discuss each question below in their group and write down any answers they come up with. It does not matter at this stage if they do not manage to answer every question, but they should take the opportunity to explore each question.

Take feedback. Is there anything they want to add to either of the two flipchart sheets?

- How does climate change affect people in your local area?
- How does climate change affect people in the UK?
- How does climate change affect people around the world?
- How does climate change affect the natural environment?
- What are the causes of climate change?
- Are the causes the same for people around the world?
- What are the solutions to climate change?
- Are the solutions to climate change the same for people around the world?
- When something happens in one part of the world, does it affect people in other places?
- How is climate change a global issue?
