Activity 3: School travel survey

You will need

- Paper and pencils

Aim

- To find out how children and staff travel to school.
- To lead to action to reduce the amount of fossil fuel used to travel to school.

What to do

This is another activity that can be done as a whole class or by a group.

Remind the children that another way in which schools may contribute to climate change is by the way children and adults travel to school. Ask them to devise and carry out a survey of the way the people in the class travel to school. They can then produce graphs of the results.

The results could be used in the future to develop a school travel plan.
