

# Global Citizenship in the Whole School: Early Years

## Lesson plan 4: Dinosaurs and all that rubbish

**Age group: 3 - 5**

### **Aims:**

For pupils to gain a sense of the future, begin to identify unfairness, and have an appreciation of their own environment and of living things.

### **What to do:**

You will need:

- the book: *Dinosaurs and all that Rubbish* by Michael Foreman.

Read the story to the class and then ask:

- was the man right to make such a mess and then just leave it?
- was the man right to say everything belonged to him when he came back?
- what did he learn from the dinosaurs?
- what can we learn from this story?

Role-play short extracts of the story. Follow up by talking about how to take care of things in the classroom. Ask pupils to identify what needs tidying up.

### **Planned outcome:**

That pupils begin to learn that we all have responsibilities towards the Earth.
