Oxfam works with partners and communities around the world to tackle poverty and inequality.



Ali is a farmer and father living in the Sanaag region of Somaliland. After losing much of his livestock to drought, Ali moved into agricultural farming to try and adapt to the effects of the climate crisis. Working alongside Oxfam partner, the Somali Resilience Program, his farm and its new solar-powered well are helping to build unity and support the local community.





RESPONDING IN AN EMERGENCY: AWAD'S STORY



Awad lives in the village of Deir Mimas in southern Lebanon. After the town's only generator was destroyed in airstrikes, there was no access to a reliable water supply and daily tasks like washing hands, cooking and bathing became a challenge. Oxfam worked with partners to repair the destroyed generator, which restored water and electricity to the village.

voices for equality: Magdalene's Story



Magdalene lives in Sierra Leone and founded the Female Pastors Network (FEMINET), a womenled farming cooperative which transformed food production in her local community. With support and training from Oxfam's local partners, Magdalene found ways to tackle malnutrition in her community by turning cassava into fortified flour. With a grant, FEMINET were also able to buy land, providing business sustainability and empowering local women.
