HOW TO HOST YOUR OWN WIMBLEDON SWEEPSTAKE



Organising your own sweepstake is a fun and easy way to raise money. You can run sweepstakes for the men's, women's or doubles tournament.

- 1. On the Friday before Wimbledon starts, they announce the top 32 seeds. Find out which players are participating in the event, and write their names on the sheet opposite.
- 2. Cut out the names and fold them in half twice. Place them in a hat.
- **3.** Ask your friends to draw a ticket from the hat for a small donation (you can set your own suggested donation, we think £1 or £2 works well in most offices).
- **4.** Keep a note of which player each individual draws from the hat, in the box below.
- **5.** Enjoy the tennis!
- **6.** Game, set and match... After the final, award the winning individual with a prize. This could be a novelty prize, or a percentage of the donations (whichever option you choose, you should make this clear from the beginning).
- **7.** Send the remainder of the donations to Oxfam, and update your online fundraising page with your latest offline donations.
